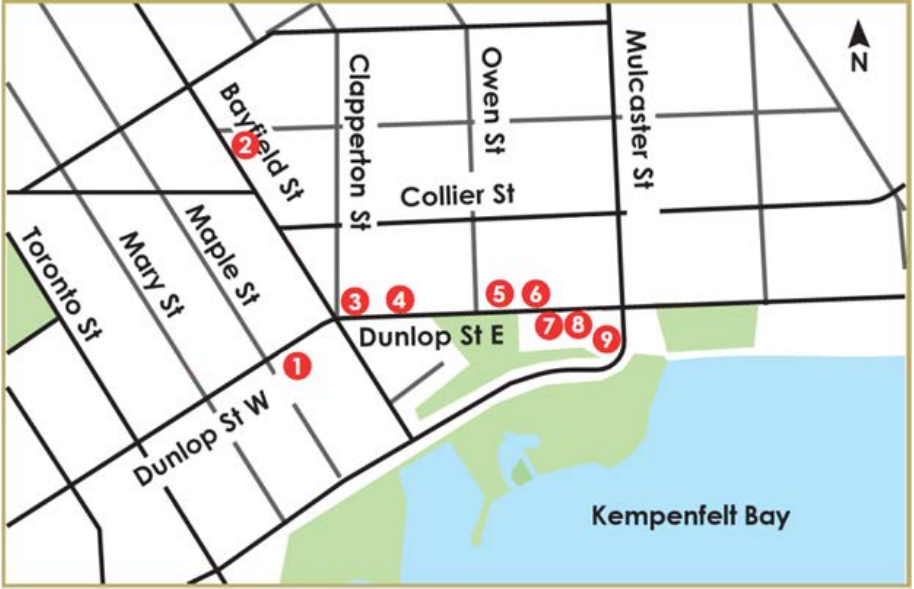


Brightening Barriers

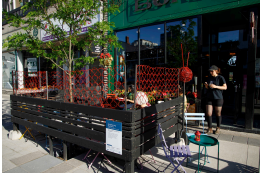
